- Be comfortable teaching World history and U.S. history
- Serve as a high school advisor
- Be comfortable teaching skills including critical problem solving, writing, speaking, questioning, and researching
- Be expected to contribute to the school's extracurricular offerings
- Have the ability to design and facilitate rigorous, empowering lesson plans that are student-centered and thought-provoking
